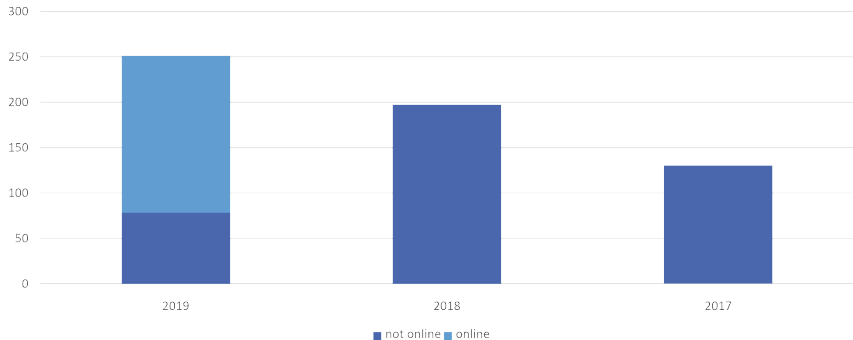

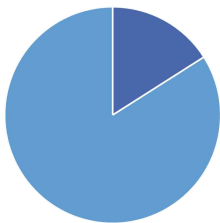

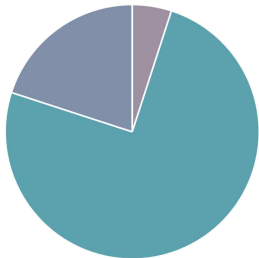


ANTI-SEMITIC HATE SPEECH DURING THE PANDEMIC 2020

ITALIAN CONSTITUTION

Art. 3

All citizens have equal social dignity and are equal before the law, without distinction of sex, race, language, religion, political opinion, personal and social conditions



Art. 21

All persons have the right to express freely their ideas by word, in writing and by all other means of communication
